

# Unmanned Aircraft Systems Basic Pilots Course

The UAS Basic Pilots Course is 32-hours of instruction designed specifically and **ONLY** for agencies with an established UAS program and flying missions with protocols and a comprehensive policy in place. The curriculum focuses on piloting skills and training in UAS safety and general UAS program operations. Training begins online with FAA Part 107 test preparation culminating with an in-class test review and test scheduling assistance.

Students will:

- ➔ Prepare for the FAA UAG 107 test (test fee included in tuition)
- ➔ Explain UAS safety management strategies and safety culture
- ➔ Demonstrate UAV flight setup and pre-flight
- ➔ Demonstrate emergency safety procedures
- ➔ Explain record-keeping and courtroom testimony
- ➔ Demonstrate UAV piloting skills in basic public safety mission-sets
- ➔ Demonstrate UAV piloting skills in a competition course, under stress

Each student will receive a minimum of 8 hours of flight training as a member of a UAS deployment team and log at least 3 hours of actual flight time.
