Course Overview

This focus of the course is to educate and integrate K-9 teams with SWAT teams. Training will include tactical issues regarding tracking, area searches, building searches, vehicle barricades, arrest team tactics, and tactical movement. Training to include classroom presentations of all basic SWAT K-9 concepts, practical application of relevant skills, instructor led exercises, reality-based scenarios, and live fire. Lead instructor is an active / full-time Canine Handler - SWAT Team member from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Special Enforcement Bureau (SEB).

Equipment Requirements - Canine Handlers / SWAT Team Members

- Active-duty certified police dog
- Tactical Uniform w/ elbow / knee pads, Gas Mask, Range Ear / Eye protection
- Weapon Systems w/ weapon lights (Rifle + Pistol) 100 rounds rifle, 100 rounds pistol
- Leather agitation muzzle
 - Muzzles that prevent proper air flow will not be allowed during course
 - Plastic muzzles will not be allowed during the course
 - The muzzle used should allow the dog to breathe easily during extended searches / engagements
 - Long lines / leashes used during deployments / training
- Leather / nylon working dog harness
- Electric correction collar (if applicable)
- Appropriate housing for K-9 (either vehicle mounted canine insert or crate with cooling system)
- Flashlight
- Tactical body armor / vest, ballistic helmet, Nomex gloves or equivalent
- Communication System
