This 8-hour course is designed to meet the needs of public safety management exploring the use of Unmanned Aircraft. Attendees discover:

- Legal and operational requirements of the public agency, including FAA waivers, insurance, drones as first responders, and airspace considerations
- Evaluate UAS operations as they pertain to Privacy and Civil Rights issues and the impact on public perception
- Application of laws and regulations governing UAS aircraft
- Examination of types of UAS operations, capabilities, and limits including policy, equipment, team structure, and missions
- Evaluate the suitability for UAS operations within the operational environment
- Review of Part 107 operational waivers compared to a Public Certificate of Authorization (COA)
- Identify key resources for UAS operators to maintain currency in a changing field
