ANATOMY OF AN AMBUSH

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

"Anatomy of an Ambush" is a dynamic, media intensive course designed to reduce the reactionary gap that can lead to deadly consequences in law enforcement interactions with suspects. Real life scenarios combined with tactical considerations are discussed throughout the training that will give the student the knowledge to survive attacks. This course will give the student the ability to identify "pre-attack" clues and will give them various examples of how to address those clues before the attack occurs.

INSTRUCTOR(S):

Nathan Mendes is a law enforcement officer in Northern California and is currently assigned to a major crimes task force. He has worked in various assignments including Patrol, K9, SWAT, Sniper/observer, Homicide, Narcotics and Vice. Nathan served for six years in the U.S. Marine Corps, deploying to Ramadi, Iraq in 2004 with the 1st Marine Expeditionary Force. While in Iraq, Nathan was assigned to a Human Exploitation Team and International Police Liaison Team and held various assignments. His team was responsible for training and working along side the Iraqi Police, Emergency Response Team (SWAT) and the Iraqi Special Forces.
