LOW LIGHT PISTOL FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT



This course is designed for the law enforcement officer to learn proper light deployment with both their handheld and weapon mounted lights. This course will have a heavy emphasis on applying the fundamentals of shooting at speed while also maintaining a high level of accuracy in low light conditions. The student will learn how to shoot in a way that is more realistic and comparable to real-life engagements. In this course, the student will also be working on movement, shooting at increased distances, reloads, multiple targets engagements & decision making drills. Proper light selection and light limitations will be discussed and demonstrated. The lead instructor of this course is a California POST certified law enforcement instructor with 15 years of firearms training experience.
