Trainers completing this course will be eligible to certify and instruct the Force Options Use of Force/De-Escalation Course, which meets POST's Use of Force and Strategic Communications Perishable Skills Program subjects (Commission Regulation 1005).

This instructors' course covers the legal and policy standards regarding use of force, the duty to intercede in excessive force, and a supervisor's responsibility subsequent to a use of force incident. The course incorporates elements of implicit bias, mental health awareness, and learning strategies as they pertain to use of force and de-escalation.

<u>This course is designed to meet upcoming Use of Force</u> <u>Instructor training requirements per commission regulation 1070</u>

Upon completion, students will receive <u>all materials necessary to</u> <u>certify and teach</u> the PC § 13519.10 Force Options/De-Escalation Course. Students will also receive guidance on developing their agency's basic Use of Force PSP course.

Students are required to bring a laptop and power cord.
