Course Descriptions:

FENTANYL SAFETY & AWARENESS: 22MAY2024, 0800-1200 (AK TIME)

• This course is designed to provide law enforcement officers and other first responders an overview of the characteristics and hazards of fentanyl and synthetic opioids as we teach current tactics, techniques and procedures to mitigate hazards to first responders when fentanyl or other harmful illicit substances are present at the scene. This course provides training on the proper use and wear of personal protective equipment, and the basic first aid measures to help prevent and mitigate incidental exposure to fentanyl analogs.

SYNTHETIC OPIOID RESPONSE: 30MAY2024, 0800-1200 (AK TIME)

This course provides members of the counterdrug nexus with fundamental knowledge and overview of characteristics, hazards, and availability of synthetic opioids NOT just Fentanyl. This course is designed to train responders in the identification of synthetic opioids, and common chemical precursors. Personnel are also trained on current tactics, techniques and procedures utilized to mitigate hazards to responders during a synthetic opioid incidents.

FENTANYL RESPONSE & DECON: 31MAY2024, 0800-1200 (AK TIME)

Fentanyl Response & Decon covers the hazards and mitigation for exposure to fentanyl. This
course also teaches the students to decon small areas of fentanyl contamination on both personnel and surfaces. In addition, Tactics, Techniques, & Procedures are also taught in regards to
Decon, Initial Entry Search, and Site Safety Plans.
