

ADVANCED SEARCH WARRANTS

Class description: The Advanced Search Warrant class is a two day class designed to teach students a variety of complex search warrants. The primary focus of the class will be to familiarize students with 1546 of the Penal Code. Students will be shown not only how to write complex search warrants, but more importantly, to evaluate each of the warrant types as an investigative technique to determine which warrants are best to use in various situations. Students will be introduced to warrants covering:

- Cell phones, DVRs, and computers
- Phone pings
- Tower dumps
- Cell phone call data records
- Cell phone advanced location data
- Meta (Facebook, Instagram), Google, & Snapchat
- Google Geofence
- 1332PC arrest warrants
- Complex arrest warrants
- Cellphone Area Search

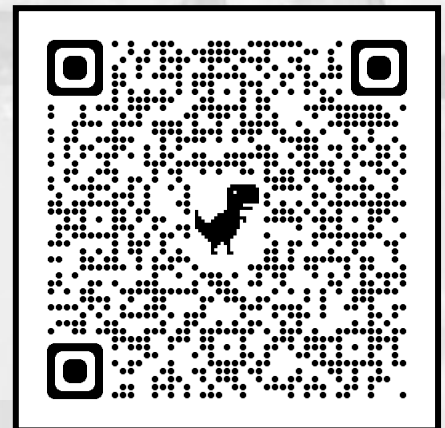
