Course Overview

This course meets the California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) guidelines (September 2019 Revision) for initial training (80 hours) of law enforcement personnel assigned to an agency's Special Weapons & Tactics (SWAT) team. Training includes all facets of basic SWAT training to include classroom presentations of all basic SWAT concepts, practical application of relevant skills, instructor led exercises, reality-based scenarios, tactical firearms qualification, written exam, and course debrief.

Conditions for course completion and POST credit:

- Must pass the tactical firearms qualification for rifle and pistol
- Must pass written exam given on last day of course
- Students failing either of the above requirements will not receive a course completion certificate or POST credit
- ***Any cancellations < 30 days and ITC cannot fill the spots, tuition is non-refundable***
- **Note: there is no PT test - physical agility testing is left to the agency as part of their selection process**

Equipment Requirements (Mandatory – Inspection on Day 1)

- (2) Tactical Uniforms – Helmet and Gas Mask w/ appropriate filter (Students will be exposed to CS gas)
- Weapon Systems w/ weapon lights (Rifle + Pistol) - 1500 rounds rifle, 1000 rounds pistol
- Dedicated marking cartridge weapon(s) and / or conversion kits
 - Simunition® and / or UTM UTX® or MMR - 200 rounds
- Simunition® full coverage mask (head / neck PPE) or equivalent
- (1) Light Sound Diversionary Device (I.e., Flashbang) (Students can bring more at Agency discretion)
- (1) 40MM Less-Lethal Impact Munition (Alternate (5) 12GA Bean Bag Shotgun Rounds)
- (4) 12GA Shotgun rounds #8 Birdshot (Breaching Shotgun Training)
- Range PPE – Eye / Ear Protection
- Tactical equipment normally carried, must include IFAK w/ tourniquet (blue training tourniquet preferred)
