We provide the basic framework to build from, resources, and ideas for you and your organization to help prepare you before an incident occurs. You will better understand the best use of De-Escalation and responses during a crisis event. You will also participate in role-playing scenarios, identifying responses that can contribute to a successful resolution.
