In this introductory level class, students will learn how to identify Google accounts, obtain account data with a search warrant, and develop an understanding of the available records provided by Google. Location History will be covered in detail. Case studies will demonstrate how to incorporate Google account data into investigations. Current legal trends related to Google, and recent policy changes, will be discussed. This lecture class is geared toward students with search warrant and investigative experience, and/or digital evidence (data) analysis experience, and prosecutors who may present this type of evidence in court.
