COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This in depth eight-hour course will focus on methods and techniques related to fugitive apprehension. This class is designed for any sworn law enforcement Officers or analysts.

INSTRUCTORS: Jeffery Castro is a Federal Agent with the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and is currently assigned with the United States Marshals Service (USMS) Fugitive Task Force. His area of responsibility is Alameda and Contra Costa County. Mr. Castro has worked in fugitive apprehension for the past 15 years. He has completed the Federal Law Enforcement Training Academy in Charleston, SC Fugitive Operation Training Program (FOTP) as well as the USMS High Risk Fugitive Apprehension (HRFA) training in Monterey Park, CA. He is the DHS Foreign Fugitive Coordinator for the San Francisco Field Office, where he works with Interpol, and other foreign governments to locate fugitives who have fled to other countries and are possibly now in the United States. He has two Associate Degrees in Liberal Studies and Criminal Justice as well as a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from California State University Hayward.

Katie Rhoe is a Deputy Sheriff with Contra Costa County Sheriff's Department and is currently assigned to the United States Marshals Service (USMS) Fugitive Task Force Team. She has worked in fugitive apprehension for six years. Prior to working on the USMSTFT, she was a member of the CCCSO street enforcement team. She has been assigned to her SWAT team for the last eight years and is an assistant team leader. She has a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice for California State University Sacramento
