SUBJECT AREAS WILL INCLUDE:

Policy and Ethics - Individual conduct, on-duty and off-duty will be discussed. The maintenance of personal integrity will be evaluated in light of the present sociopolitical problems.

Legal Constraints - The constitutional rights and organizational prerogatives will be emphasized as they relate to criminal violations and/or deviancy from administrative standards.

Officer Involved Shootings - General investigative procedures to include shooting policy, scene investigation, shootings with injuries and in-custody deaths and critical injuries.

Internal Investigation Procedures - The sequence of tasks to be performed during an internal investigation will be described.

Disciplinary Action - The various types of anticipated results of disciplinary sanctions will be analyzed.

Problem Avoidance and Identification - The manager and supervisor as a diagnostician. How to detect possible problem employees. Techniques of early corrective action.

Govt. Code 3300 et. seq. - The impact of the Peace Officer's Bill of Rights.
