Joe Belliveau began his law enforcement career in June of 1990 with the Illinois State Police. Upon graduating from the Academy, Joe was assigned to patrol where he worked for 9 years as a patrol officer and a drug interdiction officer in the St. Louis Metro East Area. In 1999, he was assigned to investigations where he spent 20 years. Joe has held positions as an agent, supervisor, and director of a 20-man undercover narcotics unit, supervisor of a Meth Response Team, supervisor of a gun unit, and supervisor of a multi-agency proactive street crimes unit in one of the most dangerous cities in the United States. Joe has been involved in thousands of undercover operations involving narcotics, firearms, car thefts, murder for hires, etc. After retiring from the Illinois State Police in 2019, Joe worked for the United States Postal Inspection Service as a Task Force Officer conducting drug and currency parcel interdiction investigations. In addition, Joe has taught narcotic-related courses to thousands of law enforcement officers across the country. He is also recognized as an expert by Illinois Courts as well as the Southern District of Illinois Federal Court.
