“Ethics in Narcotic Investigations”

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This class is designed for anyone involved in narcotics enforcement (analysts, prosecutors, peace officers) in how to handle challenges and ethical issues in narcotics enforcement such as informant management, Brady and discovery issues, privileges, and other cases considerations that could impact a case and/or career.

INSTRUCTOR: Matt De Moura, Yolo County Deputy District Attorney, has been a prosecutor since 2011, and has handled gang, firearms, narcotics, Three Strikes, and homicide cases during that time. He is currently cross designated as a Special Assistant United States Attorney with the Sacramento Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) and serves as a HIDTA Initiative Commander. He is an Academy instructor and has taught Search and Seizure for several years. He regularly reviews State and Federal search warrants and advises on search and seizure issues.
