COURSE DESCRIPTION

This class will train Officers on what to look for on modified vehicles related to the import and domestic street racer, sideshow events, and what vehicle code sections can be cited. In addition, the training will include sideshow culture and sideshow trends. There will be a hands-on portion of the training on modified vehicles.

You **DO NOT** need a background in vehicle mechanics or components to attend. You will learn the terminology and get hands-on experience in the class.

This class is open to Sworn Officers Only Please, and has a limited class size.

INSTRUCTOR

CHP Street Racing Enforcement Unit Officer

The instructor is in his 8th year with the California Highway Patrol out of the South Los Angeles Area. He has spent the last three years working on the California Highway Patrol Southern Division Street Racing Enforcement Unit. He has taught street racing, takeover, and takeover culture classes for CNOA, CGIA, POALAC, law enforcement agencies throughout California, The Los Angeles and San Diego District Attorneys Office, and the London Metropolitan Police Department. He has spent hundreds of hours responding to these illegal meets, investigating street racing-related incidents, arresting offenders, and interacting with members of the public who have been victimized by those conducting this malicious, illegal activity. As a CHP Street Racing Enforcement Unit officer, he has written over 100 vehicle seizure court orders for reckless driving, investigated other felonious criminal activities associated with takeovers and street racing, written follow-up search warrants, and provided intelligence on takeovers and street racing.
