This course is designed as an introduction to the world of performance shooting. Students will be exposed to drills on how to apply the fundamentals of shooting at speed while also maintaining a high level of accuracy. Students will learn how to shoot in a way that is more realistic and comparable to real life engagements. On day one of the course, students will be working on refining their grip, trigger press and vision. Day one will also include movement, shooting at increased distances, reloads and target transitions.

Day two will be learning proper light deployment with both handheld and weapon mounted lights all while maintaining a high level of performance. Students will be exposed to strong hand only shooting, handheld flashlight techniques, weapon mounted light (WML) techniques, handheld to WML transitions, decision making drills and multiple target engagements. Proper light selection and light limitations will be discussed and demonstrated.
