

# UAS RECURRENT PILOT TRAINING



This course is a comprehensive two-day program tailored for COA and Part 107 UAS pilots engaged in public safety operations designed to cater to agencies with established UAS programs. Throughout the training, participants will engage in intermediate pilot exercises to build and enhance confidence in their UAS flying skills, ensuring a high level of proficiency in various operational scenarios.

Utilizing the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Aerial Test Methods, students will complete Level 3 Open and Level 4 Obstructed courses, providing participants with a structured approach to objectively evaluate and measure the proficiency and control of UAV piloting. Additionally, the course delves into flight management software and drone software settings, enabling pilots to optimize their UAS performance and leverage advanced functionalities. Emphasis is placed on intermediate public safety flying skills, ensuring that participants are well-equipped to navigate complex and dynamic situations that may be encountered during public safety operations.
