The Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting an **eighty (80) hour, two-week POST certified *Motorcycle Training Instructor* course**. This course is designed for riding BMW, Harley Davidson, Honda, or Kawasaki motorcycles. Agencies are required to send officers with agency bikes to ride for this course. The program is primarily "hands-on" training augmented with in-class material. Adult Learning Concepts for student instruction, instruction techniques & handouts are covered.

- Figure 8's and Circles
- Off-set 90's (flat and incline)
- Intersection, Keyhole, Short Cones
- 40 Deceleration (braking)

- 180 Deceleration (Braking & Turning)
- 30 MPH Cone Weave, Incline Figure 8's
- Slow Ride, Dirt Ride
- Incline Start & Stop U-Turn, Apexing
- The "HURT" Study and Car Stops & Firearms
