**About this Webinar:** This two-hour webinar will focus on training officers on the three key components required for a guilty verdict: investigating cases beyond a reasonable doubt, accurately documenting the investigation, and professionally presenting the case to the jury. Topics will include tips for investigating cases, how to "paint a picture" during direct examination and include a discussion about the most common defense attorney tactics and how to address them during testimony.
