#### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Sometimes in law enforcement, different areas of expertise or capacity are often seen as separate entities, courses of action, or responsibilities. This class was created to challenge that notion and blends two areas together: human trafficking investigations and tactical operations. This highly interactive class will focus on a beginning to end tabletop scenario with learning points driven home via case law exploration, industry standard concepts, and real-life case studies. Concepts to be covered will include:

- Human Trafficking Laws
- PC 835a discussion
- Human Trafficking Investigative Techniques
- Operational Planning: Patrol and Tactical Teams
- Thinking About HT Victims
- Day Of Operation
- Linking Evidence for a Fileable Case
- Liability, Record Keeping, and Report Writing

#### INSTRUCTOR(S):

**Sgt. Kyle Baker** began his career with Pittsburg Police Department in 2010. Since then, he has held numerous positions to include patrol, SWAT, FTO, RTO, and department trainer. In 2016, he was selected as a detective to the Special Investigations Unit where he began investigating human trafficking and commercial sex cases. Kyle teaches human trafficking related topics around the State of California, is a law enforcement advisor for national anti-human trafficking organizations, and has been featured on several podcasts.

**Cpl. Jarred Pereira:** was a state-sworn police officer and SWAT team member in the California Bay Area for approximately 12 years. Jarred spent the majority of his career in Investigations, and nearly half as a federally-sworn Task Force Officer (TFO) with Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) in Oakland, CA – focusing on sophisticated criminal organizations involved in drug trafficking, firearms trafficking, and money laundering. Jarred has led and participated in multiple large scale fentanyl trafficking and overdose death investigations. After more than a decade, Jarred recently separated from his law enforcement career in the Summer of 2024 after creating an operations and training management software company for law enforcement (Pryme Infil).
