- Management of traumatic shock.
- Management of Heat and Cold Emergencies.
- Trauma care for the injured K9 (Bleeding control, penetrating injuries, blunt injuries, eye injuries, fractures, burns, envenomation, and electrocution)
- Management of Medical emergencies (Allergic reactions, respiratory emergencies, cardiac emergencies, poisons, bloat, and seizures)

The course consists of lectures along with various skill stations as it relates to the topics listed above.
