<u>Course Description:</u> This course provides a comprehensive approach to managing the aftermath of critical incidents, recognizing that the real challenges often begin once an incident is deemed "safe." Participants will explore the long-term impact of critical incidents, which can persist for months or even years if not handled effectively. The curriculum emphasizes key areas such as leadership, agency failures, liability issues, locating critical resources, and preplanning and coordination with outside agencies.

Participants will engage in critical incident debriefs, group work, and facilitated discussions. The course bridges theory with practice, utilizing scenario-based exercises, guest speakers, and insights from real-world experiences to prepare participants for the complexities of post-incident management.

Supervisors and administrators play a vital role in guiding their teams through the aftermath of critical incidents, making effective leadership and decision-making essential to the long-term success of the agency. This course equips participants with the strategies and tools to strengthen their agency's resilience, reduce liability, and ensure a coordinated response.
