Roberto Hernandez is a Special Agent (SA) with the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) assigned to Protective Operations Services (POS) in the Orlando Region, which is responsible for protecting the Governor of Florida as well as visiting governors and other dignitaries. In 2015, SA Hernandez was tasked with creating and supervising the first FDLE Counterterrorism Squad, which included members assigned to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF). During his time in the Counterterrorism Squad, SA Hernandez established procedures and protocols later adopted agency-wide. In addition, SA Hernandez was part of the FDLE response to the Pulse Nightclub terrorist attack in 2016 as well as other CT missions. Other FDLE assignments have included; mid-level narcotics (to include prescription drug diversion), intelligence, and organized crime/violent crimes (to include criminal gangs). Prior to joining FDLE, SA Hernandez was a member of the Orange County Sheriff's Office for nine years, five of which he served in the Gang Enforcement Unit. During his tenure, the Gang Enforcement Unit was selected gang unit of the year by the Florida Gang Investigators Association three out of the five years.
