Course Description:

This 8-hour course is for peace officers, federal law enforcement officers and qualified individuals assigned to intercept and record wire communications ("wiretaps"). This class covers the legal basis for California wiretap operations as well as the practical and tactical aspects of operating and monitoring a wiretap. Penal Code Section 629.94 requires successful completion of this course before seeking authorization for, or participating in, wiretap operations.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this course and a written examination, students are certified by the Office of the Attorney General of the State of California to participate in wire intercept operation.

Instructor:

Dale Kitching, Supervising Deputy District Attorney (ret.), has over 35 years of experience with the Sacramento County District Attorney's Office, which included 5 years as supervisor of the Career Criminal Unit and 18 years in the Major Narcotics Unit. Concurrent with his service in the DA's office he served as a Special Assistant United States Attorney for 20 years. He was also a Special Agent, Federal Bureau of Investigation (1977-1981). He is a past recipient of the California Narcotic Officers' Association Prosecutor of the Year award. Mr. Kitching is recognized throughout California for his expertise in electronic surveillance procedures and has provided instruction to thousands of law enforcement personnel on this subject.
