

Women's Self-Defense for Law Enforcement

Restricted to Law Enforcement Women only!

Course Description:

This course is built around Section 7286.5 of California Government Code under Chapter 17.4 - Law Enforcement Use of Force Policies. This section prohibits any law enforcement agency from using any kind of carotid choke holds, carotid restraints, or any techniques that could result in positional asphyxia. The course instead focuses on control, apprehension, distance management, and other courses of action through the utilization of Jiu Jitsu techniques to aid officer safety.
