



# Murder by EME

## The Carmen Rodriguez Homicide Study

Carmen Rodriguez was the wife of Mexican Mafia member, Andrew “Huero” Rodriguez. On January 18, 2017, Rodriguez was lured to the City of San Bernardino where she was executed in the parking lot of Gaby’s Cafe. Five suspects were, ultimately, identified through a lengthy investigation which included wire taps, cell phone analysis, Google records, and Facebook search warrants; three of these suspects were in state custody when the murder was planned and carried out.

Three months after Rodriguez’s death, “Huero” was found unresponsive in his cell at Pelican Bay State Prison; he was believed to have died as a result of a “hot shot.” After the homicide case was filed in San Bernardino County, another suspect was murdered in his cell just two days prior to his scheduled transport from Kern Valley State Prison to San Bernardino.

This presentation will give you a look into how the Mexican Mafia used their power to order the murder of a fellow member’s wife. The presenter will discuss events leading up to the homicide and how electronic communications were instrumental in identifying the suspects responsible. Lessons taught will be the importance of obtaining corroborating evidence when using co-conspirator statements and how critical these statements are to obtaining a conviction.
